Each cabin has electric outlets, large banks of storage space, and indoor plumbing with a bathroom containing at least 3 toilet stalls, 3 single showers, and 4 sinks. Campers are supervised by supportive, well-thought counselors who are totally there for them.



ILC Sound City stands firmly behind the idea that the greatest bonds are built on common love for music! Sound City is comprised of campers and counselors from across the globe creating an eclectic mix of musical tastes and genres. This department puts on a variety of performances and shows throughout the summer including talent shows, open mic night, live music for our theatre production, and our camp music festival- ILC Woodstock.

We offer lessons in guitar, bass, and drums, as well as vocals and song writing. Lessons are individually tailored to the needs of every camper musician. We also offer band classes which are organized for groups of campers to collaborate and work together under the close guidance of a band manager to play a final performance at the end of the session. The Sound City Beach Stage and the Woodstock Stage are fantastic venues to practice and perform.

Additionally, ILC has a fully equipped, purpose-built recording studio, where campers are writing, recording, producing and mixing music. Both individual musicians and group bands will receive recording time with a production engineer and get to learn the recording process. These recordings are a fantastic way to share their craft with family and friends. Electronic music and DJ classes are favorites and campers have the opportunity to DJ at camp events like pool parties, dance party celebrations, and on performance day.




Camp is my....exit stage left

ROLE PLAYING GAMES



RPG's include Dungeons and Dragons, Star Wars, Magic: The Gathering and many other games from the realms of fantasy, science fiction, horror and heroic adventure. Campers will get to hone their skills of strategy while making new camp friends who share their same interests. These are not computer games; campers work together in small groups led by a game master with an emphasis on creativity, team-work and storytelling. The games are brought to life in a fantastic activity called LARP: Live Action Role Playing. One of our most popular activities, LARPing involves battles with foam swords and shields. This is obviously a great way to get outside and get into character! For more technically oriented kids, we offer a comprehensive rocketry program with resources to build flying models that range from a few inches tall, traveling a hundred feet in

the air up to massive seven foot rockets and

heights measured in thousands of feet.

Expect the unexpected within these magic classes and you will be guaranteed to leave with a smile. Magic at ILC is taught using a uniquely fun and dynamic method involving interactive games, thought provoking puzzles, and exercises which introduce the camper to the underground science of sleight of hand and clever trickery.

The department is run by experienced magicians who bestow their wisdom on campers of all ages. The classes are divided into 3 main categories: Beginners, Advanced and Illusion Workshop. Campers can also attend on a daily basis simply to learn a trick with the Trick-A-Day class.

Whether you've grown up on the back of a horse or never even seen one before, all horse and pony lovers are welcome! Our 10 horses, ranging from Shadow the tiny but cheeky pony, to Quint the gentle giant, we will find your perfect horsey friend! Enjoy lessons in both English or Western riding, show jumping and dressage, stable management, & lunging lessons.

All campers are welcome to join in other horsemanship activities that allow them to interact with the horses from the ground: daily horse care, grooming & braiding, and how to tack up a horse. Riders can choose to work on skills lessons in our arena or go on a trail ride where they can view our beautiful camp from the back of a horse.






Camp is my....grind

The Aerial Adventures outdoor course is a complex of high ropes elements including Climbing Wall Tower, Earthquake bridge, Cargo Net, Monkey vines, Pirates crossing, & of course the rush of the Giant Swing & Leap of Faith. Harness your inner ninja warrior to get through the obstacle course of wrecking balls, boxing bags & flying discs.

Then, go to our indoor climbing wall gym to work up through the various levels of routes before rappelling down. Interested in getting technical? Our staff will teach you all about different types of knots and holds, proper body positioning, climbing technique, and bouldering. There is really something for everyone so get "On Belay" and "Climb On!"


