CONFIRMATION OF APPLICATION

Within one week each camper will receive an acknowledgment his/her application has been received. **If you do not receive confirmation within one week, please call the High Point office.** Parent Information, a medical form and camper confidential form will be mailed in the spring.

Applications are accepted in the order received. Should your application be received after capacity is reached, you will be notified via postcard or e-mail that your child's name has been placed on the waiting list.

LOCATION

Camp Cheerio is located in the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina, twelve miles south of Sparta (just off Highway 21) and 58 miles northwest of Winston-Salem.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

A written statement must accompany cancellation due to illness or accident from the child's physician. Only these will receive a full deposit refund. Any cancellation received prior to April 1, for any other reason will be refunded one half the deposit. **After April 1, NO DEPOSIT REFUNDED.** No refund of fees will be given if a child cancels one week prior to session. Camp fees are not discounted when campers arrive late or leave early except for withdrawal due to illness or accident. In case of dismissal from camp, there will be no refund. The deposit of an applicant on the waiting list is processed when a space becomes available.

VISITATION

Camp provides an opportunity for campers to gain the self-confidence and independence important to a young person's development; therefore, the camp program should not be interrupted with visits by relatives or parents. An Open House will be held in April for parents to see camp and meet staff.

Please do not bring cell phones to camp! Cell phones found at camp will be confiscated and returned on closing day. Ipods may be used only during rest period. Cell phones used as music players are not permitted.

ADVANCED RIDING

Offered all sessions. Campers must be 11 or older and be advanced riders. Campers will ride for one hour each day during the one week sessions (4 Days), and one hour **every other day** during the two week sessions (5 days). Campers will have advanced instruction, take trail rides, assist in horse care and tacking. Class size is limited to five children per activity period. Space is limited (\$130 one week/\$160 two weeks). We will continue to offer our regular horseback riding class as an activity with no charge.

C.R.E.W.

CREW is a leadership program for our oldest campers (Rising 10th graders). Campers spend time together each day learning leadership skills, teambuilding, doing service projects, hiking trips, etc. The majority of last year campers register for CREW. LOCATION

Cheerio Adventures is located in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Southwest Virginia, near Mouth of Wilson. The site is on the banks of the New River, 12 miles NW of Sparta, NC

CONFIRMATION OF APPLICATION

Within one week each camper will receive an acknowledgment his/her application has been received. **If you do not receive confirmation within one week, please call the High Point office.** A medical form, confidential form, detailed itinerary, parent's guide and other information will be mailed in the Spring.

SPENDING MONEY

It is recommended \$25 be brought to camp with the camper for one week sessions, \$35 for two week sessions, and \$50 for Trekkers, Seekers and Mountains to the Sea. Spending money is not included in the camp fee and should not be sent with the fee. Campers are responsible for their money.

WHO MAY ENROLL

Any boy or girl 10 – 17 years of age at the time of the camp session, provided they meet age requirements for the trip they choose, may enroll. All Cheerio Adventure sessions are coed (with the exception of Extreme 1 which is all girls). Applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Camp management reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any applicant deemed undesirable or not in the best interest of Camp. Children who may pose a risk to themselves or other campers or staff may be dismissed from their session with no refund of fees. Cheerio Adventures reserves the right to cancel any session, which low enrollment makes operation financially impractical.

HEALTH/MEDICAL INFORMATION

Basic First Aid Services at Cheerio Adventures are included in the camp fees. However, outside treatment and prescriptions are billed to the parents or parent's insurance. A health and authorization form for emergency treatment will be mailed in the Spring. Each year a new form must be completed and signed by a physician and must include immunization record and physician record. You must bring the completed forms with your child on opening day.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Campers should arrive between 2:00 and 3:00 PM on opening day. Closing day departure is between 9:00 and 10:30 AM.

Cheerio Extreme campers are dropped off at Cheerio Adventures at the New River Outdoor Center (NROC) in Mouth of Wilson, VA and picked up at the end of the session at Camp Cheerio in Glade Valley, NC.

DIGITAL DEVICES

Please do not bring cell phones to camp! Cell phones found at camp will be confiscated and returned on closing day. Ipods may be used only during time in base camp tents and cabins and bus travel. Cell phones used as music players are not permitted.

DISCOUNT

Immediate families with more than one child will receive a sibling discount of \$50 for a two week session and \$25 for a one week session for all siblings after the first child. A full \$300 deposit must be paid for each child and each session.

EQUIPMENT

The majority of the gear/equipment for the adventure is provided. This includes tents, backpacks, sleeping bags, sleeping pads, PFD's, canoes, bicycles and more. Campers may bring their own equipment, but the staff will evaluate the appropriateness of personal gear on the first day. If equipment is found to be inadequate, the gear needed will be issued. Cheerio Adventures is not responsible for any damage or loss of personal equipment.

GROUP SIZE AND MAKE UP

Most groups are coed. The mixture of boys and girls in each group varies according to the order registrations are received. All participants are registered on a first received, first enrolled basis. If your child is the only boy or girl in a session you will be contacted in advance with options. A coed staff team leads all trips.

The maximum number of campers on each trip varies from 8–12 depending on the trip. Each trip has a minimum of two staff at all times. The small size of the group allows more individual attention for each camper.

NEW RIVER OUTDOOR CENTER

Cheerio Adventures' base camp rests on the banks of the historic New River. While in camp, each group has two large platform tents with bunk beds; one tent is for girls and one is for boys. Counselors sleep in the tents with the campers. A large bathhouse takes care of shower and toilet needs. While in camp, campers enjoy a variety of activities including: an 825 foot zip line, a giant slide, sand volleyball, frisbee, mountain boards, GAGA and more.

STAY OVER CAMPERS

Campers staying more than one session or combining an Adventure and Traditional experience may stay in camp for a fun-filled day. Possible activities include caving, canoeing or tubing. Campers may launder their clothes. The day is well supervised. The stayover fee is \$60 each session.

AIRPORT PICK UP AND RETURN

There is a charge of \$70 per immediate family for pickup and return; \$60 for one way. The business office needs arrangements and payment at least two weeks prior to the session enrolled. Please no flights before 9:30 AM or after noon. Flights must be through Piedmont Triad International Airport in Greensboro, NC (GSO).
